



For many native Mulberry-ians, counting the number of phosphate companies in the area in the 1980's takes ten fingers and ten toes. Today, that list is much more condensed and comprised solely of The Mosaic Company, formed in 2004 through a merger of Cargill Crop Nutrition and IMC. Throughout the months of October and November, Mosaic employees from across the world gathered to commemorate the company's 10 year anniversary.

During this 10 year celebration,

employees reflected on their accomplishments together and on giving back to the communities where employees live and work. Mosaic facilities provided one-time \$10,000 gifts to local non-profit organizations. In total, they gifted \$370,000 to help








The New Year is underway and the city is ready to tackle new goals and projects.


All around the city, the city's Utilities and Public Works staff are working to improve Mulberry with beautification and maintenance projects. The city pool has received

a new pumping system, which separates the main pool from the children's pool. The new water treatment facility is nearing completion. New sidewalks are being poured. Roadways are continuously being upgraded to allow easier travel on city roads. The city's "Finding of Necessity Study" for a municipal Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) was approved unanimously by the Polk County Board of County Commissioners in November. A Community Redevelopment Agency is designed to alleviate designated areas of slum and industrial blight in order to promote growth in the city's private sector. The approval of the "Finding of Necessity Study" allows the Mulberry City Commissioners, city staff, and city representatives to begin working on the CRA's Master Plan, which will guide the CRA Board in how to proceed with strategic projects and funding for the coming years in the designated CRA areas. Workshops are underway, and all involved hope to finish the Master Plan as soon as possible.


